### APR 22, 2026 MINUTES:

The meeting was called to order by Cheryl at 7:07 PM EDT.

#### A. WELCOME & ROLL CALL (Cheryl Kupan)

Cheryl opened the meeting at 7:07PM. The meeting began with participants discussing a recent swimming competition, where Zena performed well in multiple events including breaking national records. Ryan and his wife celebrated their 10-year anniversary by attending a swimming competition in Greensboro, which was also their honeymoon destination in 2016.

#### B. APPROVAL OF THE LAST MEETING'S MINUTES (Zena Courtney)

The board reviewed the meeting minutes from January 21, 2026, and approved them an edit to change US-14 to UC14. Motion by Jim Matysek to approve minutes with edits, second by Zena Courtney, all in favor, none opposed. **Motion passed.**

#### C. FINANCE REPORT (Terri Goodman)

Terri presented her seven page finance report (correcting the date from 202-04-21 to 2026-04-21), showing the LMSC's net worth increased from over \$107,000 at the end of last year to nearly \$111,000 as of yesterday. The report detailed income of \$13,204 and expenses of \$9,387 for the first nearly four months, resulting in a net positive effect of \$3,817, with no major concerns noted about the LMSC's financial health. Terri and Anna Lea reported that the new Meet Stipend process is going smoothly. Teri also reported that she filed the 990 postcard, Sunbiz registration with the registered agent for the LMSC as Cheryl, and the USMS Finance Report which was not due until April 30, 2026. Motion by Zena Courtney to approve report, second by Andy Kroupa, all in favor, none opposed. **Motion passed.**

#### D. COMMITTEE REPORTS

##### 1) Awards – (Ryan Kloppe)

The FL LMSC Awards ceremony was held on March 21 at the North Shore Pool (Classroom) following the Bob Beach Championship. We had very low attendance, more awards were sent

for hand delivery than passed out. Social budget was not used based on timing of the meet completion vs food delivery. Kickboard awards were \$388.75. There was a mixed reception on the kickboard awards decision. There are 5 kickboards remaining.

### 2) Membership (Cindi Wood)

Cindi sent a report but could not make the meeting. Membership numbers were reported by Anna Lea as 2005 members at this time compared to 1988 members at this time last year.

### 3) Coaches (Scott Bay)

Scott could not make the meeting. No report submitted.

### 4) Open Water & Long Distance (Andy Kroupa)

Andy shared that the April 4-5 USMS Open Water Nationals at Nathan Benderson Park went well. Even though the USA Swimming's Open Water National and Junior Championship events were in same venue, the Masters events had to use a separate timing system that required exiting the water and crossing a finish line on the beach at the finish. There was also a Swim Trek open water clinic. Andy reported that there are no sanctioned USMS or LMSC events planned for the rest of the year, though Swim Across America in Tampa Bay is upcoming on May 9th.

### 5) Official Reports (Cindi Wood)

No new news from the Officials meetings. Cindi reported that some minor changes to the backstroke starts are in the works, but nothing concrete. Cindi will keep us posted on any changes.

### 6) Newsletter/Webmaster (Meegan Wilson)

Meegan updates the website, including posting reports and minutes, as she receives them. She has updated the Club Information page on the website. The name of the club UNAT has been changed to Southwest Florida Aquatics (SWFA). She is working on the May newsletter. She has sent out a request for club news as well as Board news. A few clubs have already sent submissions. If anyone on the Board is planning to submit something, please let her know. She requested Cheryl and Ryan's input and would like to send the newsletter out by May 1st, if possible.

### 7) Senior Games (Carter Elliott)

Carter is out of country and sent a brief report.

### 8) Sanctions & Top Ten (Anna Lea)

Anna Lea reported that USMS launched a new sanction system on March 9. Anyone applying for a USMS sanction or USMS recognition for a meet is now required to have a USMS "MyAccount" login. If the meet director is a USMS member, they use the same login as they use for their USMS membership account. If the meet director is not a USMS member, they are required to create a "MyAccount" login. She reported that some issues with the new system have caused confusion among meet directors and other issues have caused confusion for sanctions chairs. Anna Lea also provided a list of the upcoming meets for 2026.

**9) Records (Jim Matysek)**

Jim reported that he updated the LMSC records for the three courses (SCY, SCM, LCM) and provided to Meegan who promptly updated the website. He will update at the end of each season except for including the Rowdy meet result from January. He also noticed the postal events records needed updating, he will work on that next. Meegan shared information that at the SWAG meet, 90-year-old swimmer, Ambrose Gaines, completed his first 50 yard freestyle.

A motion was made by Jim Matysek to approve all Committee reports, second by Kirk Clear, all in favor, none opposed. **Motion passed.**

**E. OLD BUSINESS**

Kirk and Cheryl continue to work on the bylaws; updates were postponed due to other LMSC matters. Goal is to have an update for 2026 Annual Meeting. No update from Ed Dawson on the lawsuit.

**F. NEW BUSINESS**

None

Cheryl thanked everyone for their work before adjourning. A motion was made by Zena Courtney to adjourn, second by Anna Lea Matysek, all in favor, no one opposed. **Motion passed.** The meeting adjourned at 7:44 PM.

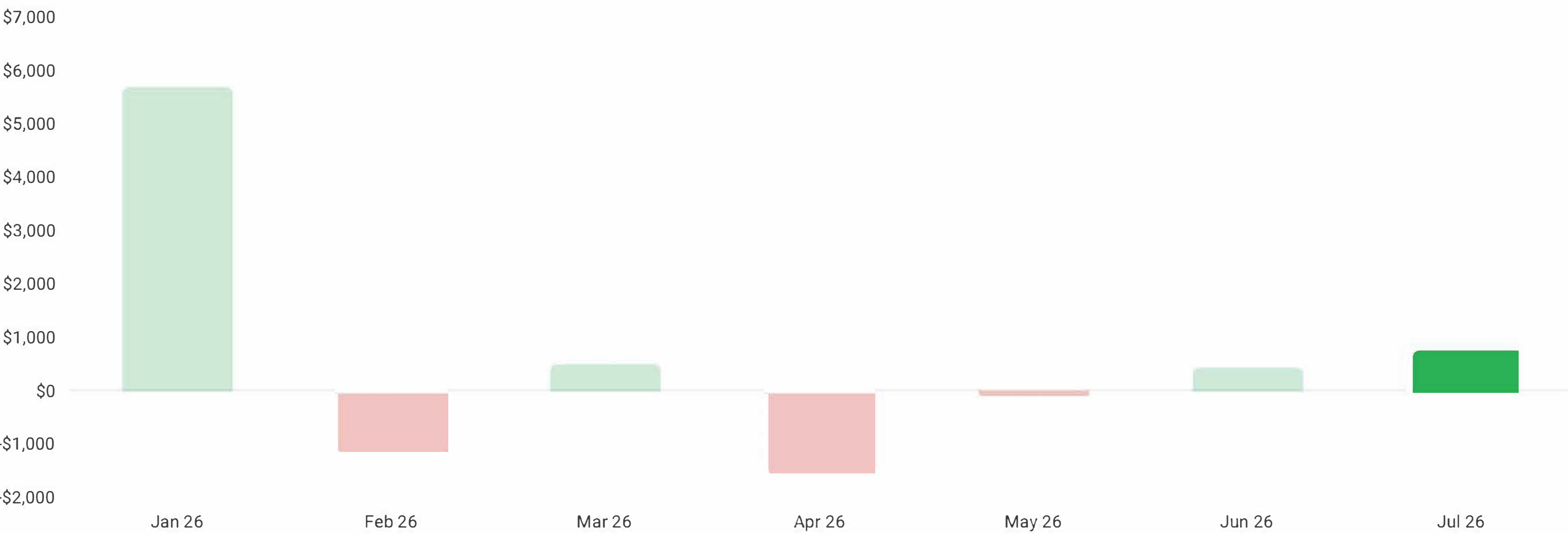

## ***New USMS Sanction Software***

USMS launched a new sanction system on March 9. As I wrote in my April report, our meet directors had various issues with the new software that required assistance from USMS. There are fewer meets that are held in the Florida LMSC in the summer and fall, but those who have recently applied for sanctions have had issues. I have been modifying the instructions I send to meet directors based on the types of problems they have experienced and hope that will help.

## ***Meets in the Florida LMSC for 2026***

The Long Center pool in Clearwater has been undergoing a major renovation. I have checked with their management but they have still not been able to give me a date for when they might be able to host a Masters meet.

### ***Florida LMSC Meet Stipend Policy***

A new meet stipend policy is in effect for 2026 meets. This policy was proposed and approved at the 2025 Florida LMSC Annual Meeting. Upon successful completion of a sanctioned meet, the LMSC will send a stipend to the meet host to cover the costs of financial gifts for the officials, assist with the costs of online meet entry, and any other meet expenses. Details of the policy are posted [in this document on the Florida LMSC website](#) and I am directing meet hosts to that document prior to approving their sanctions.

### ***Immediate USMS Rules Changes***

World Aquatics (AQUA) and USA Swimming (USA-S) have updated their respective competitive regulations for the finish rules of butterfly, backstroke, and freestyle. Swimmers are now permitted to be fully submerged once their heads have passed the final 5-meter or 5-yard mark immediately prior to reaching the finish.

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This email is sent on behalf of the USMS Rules Committee.

World Aquatics (AQUA) and USA Swimming (USA-S) have updated their respective competitive regulations for the finish rules of butterfly, backstroke, and freestyle. Swimmers are now permitted to be fully submerged once their heads have passed the final 5-meter or 5-yard mark immediately prior to reaching the finish.

The modification to the wording for each article within the U.S. Masters Swimming Code of Regulations and Rules of Competition (rule book) can be seen below:

#### Article 101.3 Butterfly

101.3.5 **Finish**—At the finish, the body shall be on the breast and the touch shall be made with both hands separated and simultaneously at, above, or below the water surface. Once some part of the head of the swimmer has passed the final 5-meter mark (long course and short course meters) or 5-yard mark (short course yards), immediately prior to reaching for the finish, the swimmer may be completely submerged.

#### Article 101.4 Backstroke

101.4.2 **Stroke**—Standing in or on the gutter, placing the toes above the lip of the gutter, or bending the toes over the lip of the gutter immediately after the start is not permitted. The swimmer shall push off on the back and continue swimming on the back throughout the race. Some part of the swimmer must break the surface of the water throughout the race, except it shall be permissible for the swimmer to be completely submerged during the turn and for a distance of not more than 15 meters (16.4 yards) after the start and each turn. By that point, the head must have broken the surface of the water. ~~Once some part of the head of the swimmer has passed the final 5-meter mark (long course and short course meters) or 5-yard mark (short course yards) immediately prior to reaching for the finish, the swimmer may be completely submerged prior to the touch.~~

101.4.4 **Finish**—Upon the finish of the race, the swimmer must touch the wall while on the back. Once some part of the head of the swimmer has passed the final 5-meter mark (long course and short course meters) or 5-yard mark (short course yards) immediately

prior to reaching for the finish, the swimmer may be completely submerged prior to the touch.

#### Article 101.5 Freestyle

101.5.4 **Finish**—The swimmer shall have finished the race when any part of the swimmer touches the wall after completing the prescribed distance. Once some part of the head of the swimmer has passed the final 5-meter mark (long course and short course meters) or 5-yard mark (short course yards), immediately prior to reaching for the finish, the swimmer may be completely submerged.

The language below is the final wording in force as of the date of this memo. All swim meets from this point forward shall be officiated using this updated language.

#### Article 101.3 Butterfly

101.3.5 **Finish**—At the finish, the body shall be on the breast and the touch shall be made with both hands separated and simultaneously at, above, or below the water surface. Once some part of the head of the swimmer has passed the final 5-meter mark (long course and short course meters) or 5-yard mark (short course yards), immediately prior to reaching for the finish, the swimmer may be completely submerged.

#### Article 101.4 Backstroke

101.4.2 **Stroke**—Standing in or on the gutter, placing the toes above the lip of the gutter, or bending the toes over the lip of the gutter immediately after the start is not permitted. The swimmer shall push off on the back and continue swimming on the back throughout the race. Some part of the swimmer must break the surface of the water throughout the race, except it shall be permissible for the swimmer to be completely submerged during the turn and for a distance of not more than 15 meters (16.4 yards) after the start and each turn. By that point, the head must have broken the surface of the water.

101.4.4 **Finish**—Upon the finish of the race, the swimmer must touch the wall while on the back. Once some part of the head of the swimmer has passed the final 5-meter mark (long course and short course meters) or 5-yard mark (short course yards) immediately prior to reaching for the finish, the swimmer may be completely submerged prior to the touch.

## Article 101.5 Freestyle

101.5.4 **Finish**—The swimmer shall have finished the race when any part of the swimmer touches the wall after completing the prescribed distance. Additionally, once some part of the head of the swimmer has passed the final 5-meter mark (long course and short course meters) or 5-yard mark (short course yards), immediately prior to reaching for the finish, the swimmer may be completely submerged.

This modified language will be updated in the online version of the rule book as soon as practicable. The printed rule book will be updated with publication of the 2027 edition of the rule book.

## FLORIDA LOCAL MASTERS SWIM COMMITTEE BYLAWS

(INCORPORATING ALL CHANGES as of ~~11/21/2024~~ July 2026)

**Purpose:** The purpose of the Florida Local Masters Swimming Committee (FL LMSC) shall be to promote and develop physical fitness and competitive swimming for the benefit of adult swimmers of all abilities in accordance with the standards, objectives, and goals prescribed by United States Masters Swimming, Inc. (USMS).

**Article 1: Membership**

**Article 2: Officers**

**Article 3: Directors**

**Article 4: House of Representatives**

**Article 5: Meetings**

**Article 6: Elections**

**Article 7: General Provisions**

**Article 8: Athlete's Rights, Hearings, and Rights of Appeal**

**Article 9: Amendments**

### ARTICLE 1, MEMBERSHIP:

**1.01 General:** Individual and club/workout group membership in the FL LMSC shall be upon receipt of application form approved by the FL LMSC Board of Directors, or online with the payment of a membership fee established by the Board of Directors, and shall be assessed on a yearly basis from January 1st through December 31st.

**1.01.1 Club Membership:** ~~Club membership is open to those Clubs are~~ organizations or groups of permanent character currently registered which register with USMS through the FL LMSC ~~and which that~~ are interested in fostering the purposes of this organization.

**1.01.2 Individual Membership:** Individual membership is open to any individual who is at least 18 years of age, to include athletes, coaches, officials, administrators, or persons otherwise interested in the purposes and programs of the FL LMSC.

### 1.02 Responsibilities of Members

**1.02.1 Income:** Any income received by any member from promotion of Masters Swimming or Masters Swimming events shall be used in accordance with the purposes of the FL LMSC

**1.02.12 Conduct:** Each individual and club member of the FL LMSC shall **abide** by the bylaws and any rules, regulations and policies of the FL LMSC.

**1.02.2 Participation in Events:** An event includes any sanctioned competition, clinic, club practice, or other LMSC-sponsored event. Proof of USMS registration is required prior to participation in any such event. Clubs must be registered with USMS for the current year in order for any individual member to represent that club in a sanctioned USMS competition.

**1.02.3 Representation at FL LMSC Meetings:** General members may attend any FL LMSC Board of Directors meeting. However, members shall have no voting rights except as club representative voting delegates as set forth in **Article 1, Section 3, paragraph E** of these bylaws.

## ARTICLE 2, OFFICERS:

**2.01 FL LMSC Officers:** The officers of the FL LMSC shall be a Chair, a Vice Chair, a Secretary, and a Treasurer. These positions are elected by the Board of Directors and ~~members of the House of~~delegated club Representatives.

**2.01.1 Requirements:** Officers shall be registered members of the FL LMSC in good standing.

**2.01.2 Executive Committee:** Officers shall comprise the Executive Committee; meetings of the Executive Committee shall be called by the Chair; the Executive Committee shall have authority to act for the LMSC and to create policy between Board meetings. If time allows, the Executive Committee will make every effort to inform or consult with the rest of the Board of Directors before decisions are finalized.

**2.01.3 Voting:** Officers shall be considered voting representatives of the FL LMSC by virtue of their office and are not required to represent their clubs as delegates, but may do so at their discretion.

## 2.02 Duties of the Officers:

**2.02.1 Chair:** ~~Duties of t~~The Chair shall include:

**a. Responsibility for the overall management and activities of the LMSC in accordance with these Bylaws and with the USMS Rule Book**

**b. Preside at over** all meetings of the FL LMSC;

**~~bc.~~** Preside as Chair of the Board of Directors;

**~~ed.~~** With the Secretary, execute all legal papers, documents, and ~~instruments-~~artifacts ordered to be executed by the Board of Directors;

**~~de.~~** Appoint the appropriate number of delegates to the ~~annual national~~ USMS ~~Annual Meeting~~convention, or annual meeting and submit their names to the National Secretary;

**~~ef.~~** Appoint chairperson positions as deemed necessary by the Board -and subject to Board approval;

**fg.** Designate either the Vice Chair, Secretary, or Treasurer to preside at meetings in his/her absence; and

**gh.** Perform such other duties as may, from time to time, be prescribed by the Board of Directors.

**2.02.2 Vice Chair:** Duties of tThe Vice Chair shall include:

a. Carry out the Chair's duties in his/~~or~~ her absence;

b. Provide support and assistance to the Chair;

c. Accept specific responsibilities from the Chair; and;

d. Take over the Chair position until the next election if the current Chair leaves office before the conclusion of his or her two-year term.

**2.02.3 Secretary:** Duties of tThe Secretary shall include:

a. Together with the Chair, execute such legal documents, papers, or ~~instruments~~ artifacts as authorized by the Board of Directors;

b. Keep Record and maintain the minutes of all meetings of the LMSC, the Board of Directors, and of the Executive Committee and ~~make-ensure~~ the minutes are available to the membership;

c. Send a copy of the FL LMSC Annual Meeting Minutes to the National USMS office as required;

d. Maintain a record of all current policies and changes in the Bylaws and forward copies to the webmaster and ~~make-ensure~~ the policies and changes are available to the membership;

e. Assume the role of parliamentarian according to Roberts Rules of Order at all meetings, if needed;

f. Preside at any meetings in the absence of the Chair and Vice Chair ~~if necessary~~; and

g. Shall Pperform such other duties as the Chair or Board of Directors may designate.

**2.02.4 Treasurer:** Duties of tThe Treasurer shall include:

a. Have charge of the funds and securities of the LMSC and cause them to be deposited into depositories approved by the Board of Directors;

b. See that an accurate record is kept of the funds and provide periodic reports to the Board of Directors;

c. Sign all checks upon bank accounts of the LMSC as directed by the Board of Directors;

d. Disburse funds and pay the bills of the ~~corporation-LMSC~~ for all expenses authorized by the Board of Directors or the Executive Committee;

e. Submit an annual proposed budget to the Board of Directors;

f. Send an Annual Financial Report to the USMS National Office, as required by USMS rules, the USMS Financial Operating Guidelines, and the USMS Guide to Operations; and

g. Preside at any meetings in the absence of the Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary ~~if necessary~~;

**2.03 Term:** Each officer shall be elected at the annual meeting and serve a term of two (2) years, such term to begin upon their election. An officer may be re-elected to successive terms.;

### ARTICLE 3, BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

**3.01 Board of Directors:** The **eight** Board of Directors shall consist of the four elected officers of the FL LMSC: (Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, and Treasurer) and the **four-elected appointed** Directors listed below: (~~Membership Coordinator, Top Ten Recorder, Sanctions Chair, and Newsletter Editor~~). Members of the FL LMSC Board of Directors (also referred to as the Board) include the following:

**3.01.1 Officers:** As defined in Article 2, these include the Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary, and Treasurer.

**3.01.2 Standing Board of Directors:** These members of the Board are appointed by the Chair, with the advice and consent of the entire Board of Directors. Once appointed, none

of these Directors can be removed without the consent of the entire Board. These are “Standing” roles on the Board, as authorized by these Bylaws. As such, if circumstances dictate functional changes are needed, the Board must vote on any proposed elimination of these Director positions or the addition of others. The following positions are standing positions with the following responsibilities:

**3.01.2.1 Membership Coordinator:** The Membership Coordinator shall coordinate with the USMS National Office on FL LMSC club and individual membership matters; keep accurate records of said club and individual registrations; ~~and assist members with requested changes or updates to their membership records and status.~~

**3.01.2.2 Sanctions Chair:** The Sanctions Chair shall oversee the competitive program to insure that the Florida LMSC program offerings are consistent with USMS and the Florida LMSC objectives, rules, and policies. This includes processing applications for meet and event sanctions, keeping accurate records of said sanctions, verifying pool measurements, promoting competent officiating, and suggesting projects and priorities to the Board of Directors.

**3.01.2.3 Top 10 Recorder:** The Top 10 Recorder shall obtain and upload meet results from all FL-LMSC sanctioned and recognized meets to the USMS event results database and prepare and submit Top 10 tabulations to USMS for national Top 10 consideration.

**3.01.2.4 Records Chair:** The Records Chair shall maintain the FL LMSC Swimming records, review meet results for potential records, report any new Zone records set by FL LMSC members to Southeastern Zone records representative, and collaborate with the Top 10 Recorder to ensure our members are recognized appropriately.

**3.01.2.5 Newsletter Editor:** The Newsletter Editor shall publish the quarterly LMSC Newsletter in February, May, August, and November. Deadlines for submissions will be announced at least two - three weeks prior to publication.

**3.01.2.6 Officials Chair:** The Officials Chair shall develop policies and procedures to assure that all LMSC for Virginia sanctioned and recognized meets and events are conducted uniformly and in conformance with the USMS swimming rules. The Officials Chair must also provide updates on rule changes and differences in USA Swimming rules and USMS rules to meet directors.

**3.01.2.7 Coaches Chair:** The Coaches Chair shall develop programs and tools to enhance the quality of Masters swimming programs and coaching within the LMSC. This includes maintaining a list of coach members within the LMSC and assisting coaches with any clinics or coaching certifications. The Coaches Chair will work in coordination with the USMS Coaches Committee.

**3.01.2.8 Open Water Chair:** The Open Water (combined with Long Distance) Chair shall promote long distance and open water events within the LMSC. The Chair will work with meet and event directors to ensure open water and long distance events meet the guidelines set out in the long distance swimming rules in the USMS rule book.

**3.01.2.9 Awards and Recognition Chair:** The . The Awards & Recognition Chair shall manage the process of recognizing various levels of participation and accomplishment by LMSC stakeholders. Responsibilities shall include vetting and presenting LMSC awards, including selection criteria and awards ceremonies, and submitting FL LMSC nominees for USMS awards.

**3.01.2.10 Senior Games Liaison:** The Senior Games Liaison shall update the Board on Senior Games events and news in the FL LMSC as well as for the National Senior Games.

**3.01.2.11 Past Chair:** The To maintain continuity on the FL LMSC board, the Immediate Past Chair shall be filled for one two year term only by the last person to hold the FL LMSC chair position. If that person is elected to another LMSC office, then the immediate past chair position shall remain vacant unless the other office is relinquished or a new Chair is elected.

**3.01.2.12 Webmaster:** The webmaster shall maintain the LMSC website, ensuring it is up-to-date and has the information most useful to our members.

**3.01.2.13 Communications and Social Media Chair:** The Communications and Social Media Chair shall be responsible for the dissemination of information from USMS and the FL LMSC to all individual members of the FL LMSC. This position shall have primary responsibility for maintaining the FL LMSC's social media assets with input from the Chair and/or Vice Chair and will be the primary person to forward communications to members via email with input from the Chair and/or Vice Chair.

**3.02 Term of Office:** The term of office for directors of the FL LMSC shall be a period of two (2) years.

**3.03 Board Powers:** The Board of Directors shall have and exercise all necessary powers to control the work and policy of the LMSC.

**3.03.1 General Powers:** The Board of Directors shall have and exercise all necessary powers to control the work and policy of the LMSC. No contract, debt, or obligation shall be binding unless contracted under the authority of the Board of Directors, except for

actions by the Executive Committee in amounts authorized herein or by the Board of Directors;

**3.03.2 Vacancies:** The Board of Directors shall have the power to fill for the unexpired terms, all vacancies occurring in their number between annual elections. Such vacancies shall be filled by first recommending names to the Board, who shall act as a nominating committee for screening and recommendation to the Chair for appointment. The term of the person filling the vacancy will last until the next regularly scheduled LMSC election.

**3.03.3 Relationships:** The Board of Directors shall have the power to enter into cooperative relationships with other agencies or organizations when, in their judgment, such relationship is desirable toward achieving the association's objectives in the area concerned. If the Board enters into Articles of Agreement setting forth the rules of such cooperative association, said agreement shall contain provisions for severing relationships at anytime, when in the judgment of the Board of Directors, it is in the best interest of the ~~association~~ LMSC to do so. The Board may delegate this power to the Executive Committee.

**3.04 Number of Board Members:** The number of Board members may be modified upon vote of the Board of Directors and approval by 50% of the team representatives;

**3.05 Number of Meetings:** The Board of Directors shall meet either in person or by ~~conference~~ electronically at least three (3) times per year. One meeting being before the October/November annual membership meeting. The other two (2) meetings shall be held during the remainder of the year as established by the Board of Directors and these articles. In addition, the Board shall hold meetings upon the call of the Chair or at the request of at least three (3) members of the Board of Directors made to the Chair. Notice of such meetings by the Chair and/or three members of the Board shall require three (3) days notice. ~~Said notice may be given via telephone or electronically;~~

**3.06 Quorums:** At all meetings of the Board, a majority of the entire Board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The consent of those members shall be sufficient to take or authorize action unless the concurrence of a greater proportion is required by applicable law, these Bylaws or the Articles of Incorporation;

#### **ARTICLE 4, HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:**

**4.01** The House of Representatives includes the Board of Directors and the Club Representatives.

#### **ARTICLE 5, MEETINGS:**

**5.01 FL LMSC Annual Meeting:** The annual meeting of the corporation shall be held during the month of October ~~or November~~ each year, provided that the USMS Annual Meeting has already occurred and new USMS rules have been adopted or the first appropriate Saturday after the USMS National Convention. The exact date shall be established by the Chair in consultation with the Board of Directors. This annual meeting will be face-to-face or virtual, and open to all LMSC members.;

**5.02 Special Meetings:** Special meetings of the ~~corporation~~ LMSC may be called at the discretion of the Chair, or upon written request of any three (3) Board Directors; ~~or~~ 15% of the LMSC members~~hip of the corporation;~~ or 50% of the club representatives. Attendees of special meeting shall be determined by the Chair, based on the subject matter.

**5.03 ~~Eligibility to Vote~~ Voting Procedures and Eligibility:** At all meetings of the FL LMSC, except as may be provided elsewhere in these Bylaws or in the Articles of Incorporation, each member of the Board of Directors and designated Club Representative~~one primary representative from each registered club that has members registered with the club~~ shall be eligible to vote on proposals.

#### 5.03.01 Eligibility:

**5.03.01.1 FL LMSC Board of Directors:** ~~Each~~ Each member of the FL LMSC Board of Directors, as described in Article 3 of these Bylaws is authorized one vote per proposal.

**5.03.01.2 FL LMSC Board of Directors:** Each -registered club in the FL LMSC will be allotted a number of representatives authorized to vote on LMSC proposals, as follows: 1-49 registered members = 1 representative; 50-99 registered members = 2 representatives; ~~and~~ 1 additional representative for each additional 100 registered members. A quorum shall consist of those present and eligible to vote.;

**5.03.01.2.1 Definitions:** ~~The term “club” for the purposes of this article~~ these Bylaws signifies those groups within the Florida LMSC who are registered with USMS.

**5.03.01.2.2** ~~Each~~ Each Florida LMSC club shall submit on a yearly basis the name(s) and contact information of each representative to the Florida LMSC Secretary. At the beginning of each meeting the Secretary will call roll of clubs present and request identity of which member(s) are representing said clubs and ensure they are listed on the roster as present along with updated contact information.

**5.03.01.2.3 Duplicate names of Clubs will not be permitted.**

**5.03.01.3-2.4** ~~Any~~ Any registered club member present at any meeting is eligible to represent their club.

**5.03.01.2.54 Members in the Florida LMSC who are not a club representative and are not on the Board of Directors will have a voice, but no vote.**

**5.034.02 Method of Voting:** At all meetings of the FL LMSC the method of voting shall be by voice vote or show of hands except on the elections of officers or on the demand of a voting member, in which case the vote shall be by written ballot, submitted to the designated Nominations Chair.

**5.04.01 Electronic Voting:** During any meeting including biannual elections, the Board of Directors and those club representatives present may vote electronically when an in person meeting does not take place. A vote may also be tabled for a period of twenty one days for the purpose of providing notification to all club representatives of said vote. All votes will be forwarded to the Secretary and an impartial member of USMS outside the Florida LMSC.

**5.03.035 Result of Voting:** A majority of the votes cast at any meeting of the ~~corporation~~ LMSC at which a quorum is present shall be sufficient to take or authorize action upon any matter, question, or proposal which is properly presented before the meeting.

**5.06 Notice of Meetings:** ~~Notice of the annual meeting and other meetings of the FL LMSC shall be sent out in written or electronic form. Notice shall be given to club representatives, who are responsible for notifying their club's membership.~~

**5.06.1 Regular FL LMSC Meetings:** Notification of the annual meeting ~~Said notice~~ shall be given no less than thirty (30) days prior to said meeting. Notification shall be sent to the entire membership through the LMSC newsletter, by email, or on the LMSC website.

**5.06.2 Special Meetings:** Notice of special meetings shall be given to members of the Board of Directors by electronic mail at least fifteen (15) days before the date of such meeting. T ~~and~~ the notice of the special meeting shall include a statement of the specific purpose or purposes for which the meeting is called.

**5.07 Organization:** At all Regular membership meetings and meetings of the Board of Directors shall adhere to Roberts Rules of Order, and the following shall be the general order of business:

1. Roll call;
2. Reading, correction and adoption of minutes;
3. Reports of Officers;
4. Reports of Committees;
5. ~~Unfinished~~ Old business;
6. Elections ~~where~~ when appropriate;
7. New business;
8. Adjournment.

## ARTICLE 6, ELECTIONS:

**6.01 Nominations:** Nomination of officers shall be by an ad hoc nominating committee appointed by the Chair. The nominating committee shall consist of the Chair, Vice Chair, and two (2) to three (3) members at large. The final slate will be presented to the club representatives no later than thirty (30) days before the election.

**6.01.1** The Corporation shall accept nominations from the floor at the Annual election meeting. The final slate will be presented to the House of Representatives;

**6.02 Eligibility:** No members may be considered as candidates for office unless they are members in good standing and unless their consent is obtained.

**6.03 Elections:** The elections for Officers shall be elected at the Annual Meeting in staggered terms as follows: Odd years the Chair and Treasurer. Even years the Vice Chair and Secretary. The elections for Directors shall be held in even numbered years at the Annual meeting. The FL LMSC may accept nominations from the floor at the Annual meeting; those eligible to cast votes for candidates are those defined in Article 5.03

**6.04 Vacancies:** Except for the Chair position, in which the Vice Chair would assume that role upon a vacancy, other vacancies of LMSC officers require a special election. Nominations and elections to fill a vacancy shall be held by the Board of Directors. The person filling the vacancy shall hold office until the next regularly scheduled LMSC election.

## ARTICLE 7, GENERAL PROVISIONS:

**7.01 Fiscal Year:** The fiscal year of the corporation shall begin on the first day of January and end on the last day of December.;

**7.02 Payment of Moneys:** All checks, notes, drafts, orders for payment of money or other evidence of indebtedness issued in the name of the corporation and all such instruments shall be signed by two authorized signatures if payments are \$250 or more. Four authorized signatures should be on file at the bank. The authorized signatures shall be of the Chair, Secretary, Treasurer and Membership Coordinator.

**7.03 Review:** The Treasurer's accounts shall be examined annually by someone other than the treasurer, appointed by the Executive Committee, who shall verify the bank balances and samplings of the revenue and expense documentation. A signed report of the findings shall be presented at the next regular meeting after their appointment.

**7.04 Removal From Office:** Any director or officer may be removed for cause by a majority vote of those members present at a properly called meeting where a quorum is present. Removal or resignation of an officer shall automatically lead to removal from the membership on the Board

and the Executive Committee. Suspension or revocation of membership in the corporation, or the absence from two (2) meetings of the corporation or the Board without sufficient cause may be cause for removal from office or membership on the Board. Requests to be excused from a meeting of the corporation or the Board must be received by the Chair or the Secretary prior to the call-to-order of any such meeting.

**7.05 Records:** All corporation records shall be open and available to inspection by members.

**7.06 Dissolution:** Upon dissolution, the net assets of the LMSC will not inure to the benefit of any private individual or corporation, but will be distributed to United States Masters Swimming, Inc. to be used exclusively for educational or charitable purposes, or, if United States Masters Swimming, Inc. is not then in existence, or is not then a corporation which is exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and to which contributions, bequests and gifts are deductible under Sections 170(c)(2), 2055(a)(2) corporation, to be used exclusively for educational or charitable purposes.

## **ARTICLE 8, ATHLETE'S RIGHTS, HEARINGS, AND RIGHTS OF APPEAL**

**8.01 General Jurisdiction:** The Board of Directors may conduct hearings on any matter affecting the LMSC, arising solely within the jurisdiction of the LMSC, and involving only members of the FL LMSC.

**8.02 Appeal:** Any registered member of the FL LMSC may appeal any decision by the Board of Directors at said hearings according to current USMS rules on Hearings and Appeals.

**8.03 Grievance Procedure:** Please refer to the Florida LMSC Grievance Procedure posted on our website and to Part 4 in the current USMS Rule Book.

## **ARTICLE 9, AMENDMENTS:**

**9.01 Adequate Notice:** These Bylaws may be amended by a majority vote of those members present at any meeting of the corporation properly called where a quorum is present. Provided that no less than fifteen (15) nor more than thirty (30) days notice of such meeting is given and that said notice shall contain an advisory that an amendment or amendments shall be included in the order of business and provided further, that a copy of the text of such proposed amendment or amendments shall be included in the notice.

**9.02 USMS:** Should any bylaw or rule changes occur at the USMS level or Florida State Statute 617 that are in conflict with current LMSC bylaws or rules, those LMSC bylaws or rules shall be considered immediately amended to conform to USMS standards. Notice of such changes will be made at the next scheduled FL LMSC meeting.
