Japan

We solicited information from each registered Club as to activities and performances—particularly Tokyo. We received three replies—one change of address and two as below:

Pete Jurczyk reported that he and Anne Wilder went to the Japan meet and found the competition friendly as he won all his events. He returned home with 5 golds for his efforts. He felt that the older Japanese were not up to our level of competition. Anne Wilder garnered 5 medals ranging from 3rd to 7th. Pete thought the meet was well run but long. After the long trip some time was needed to acclimate upon arrival. IRCC Masters.

Jack Beattie reported that the Central Florida contingent did well. Jack's Workd Record in the 50 meter Back, 32.40, was the real highlight. He was also first in the 100 meter and 200 meter Backstroke, third in the 50 meter Fly and sixth in the 100 meter Free. Chester Miltenberger carried off golds in the 50, 100 and 200 meter Breaststroke. Harwell Moseley aslo garnered three golds in the 50, 100 and 200 meter Butterfly events. Millie Hupp had a 4th and a 5th in the 100 and 200 meter Backstroke before she broke arm when she fell on the marble deck. The pool's deck was polished marble and while I don't know how many broken limbs there were Millie said she met a man with a broken arm at the hospital where hers was set. She said several falls were damaging. Despite Millie's mishap Central Florida put forth a fine team effort.

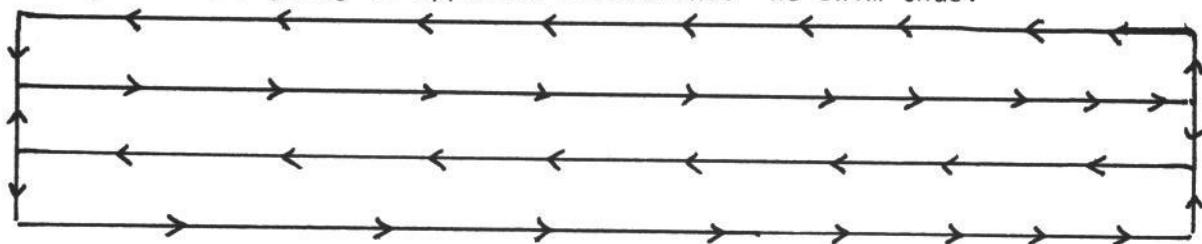
THANKS, SWEET FAT.

1st FINA/MSI WORLD MASTERS SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS - Tokyo, Japan. This was one of the greatest swim meets that I have ever been to! 907 swimmers from 18 countries were entered (including those from the USA) and 2500 Japanese. The Heat Sheets were in book form and 1/2" thick. Most days the meet started at 9 am. I swam the 400 Freestyle on the first day (there were 3 events and it was #3) and my heat swam at 7 pm. They swam two to a lane in the 400 and 800. Women started at one end and men at the other. Swam the 100 fly at 6 pm, the 200 fly at 6 pm, the 200 IM at 7:45 am and the 800 free at 5:30 pm. I won the 100 & 200 flys and the 800 free. Broke the World Records in the 200 fly and 800. Got second to Clara Walker in the 400 free and 200 IM. Everything was quite expensive in Japan. A cup of coffee was \$3.00. I ordered the meet results (for \$30.00) but have not received them as yet. The foreigners entered 4.3 events per swimmer and the Japanese only 2.2 events per swimmer. The pool was just great and they ran a wonderful meet. The awards were really something, and we received a nice plaque for our World Records.

LANE TRAINING and DISCIPLINE

With the advent of the long course training early mornings coupled with the encouragingly large numbers attending, no longer can we swim two (or even one) to a lane. So I have tried to divide the group into separate ability sets using our allotted four lanes. There are three lanes really of like ability groups with the lane and a half used for those who cannot cope with the workouts of the groups. Our names for the lanes evolved as the animals (hi-fliers), the house-pets (more sedate) and the teddy bears (they need cuddling)!

So far, this has worked extremely well, with the lanes swimming in a clockwise, counter clockwise order, thus preventing any possible clashes of arms by swimmers going in opposite directions. We swim thus:



The people in each lane have got to know each other - the camaraderie is heartening - and the efforts of the leader in each lane seem to inspire those coming behind. I hope to continue circle swimming when we go back to short course, using the same principles, with obviously less people per lane. I intend to press the Leisure Department and the North Shore management for an all year round 6:00 am start for Masters. The numbers each day prove the need for these early starts.

But all is not perfection. I do think that we would make great improvement if we could be in our lanes ready to start to swim at a given time. Some of us take too long to enter the water and then interrupt the flow of workouts. If one is late, then he or she should pick-up the workout where it's at - otherwise havoc reigns. And if one wants a social tete-a-tete, the best place is on the pool deck, not the end of the lane holding up those who have only a limited period in which to swim. We might even arrange a conversation area!!!

That off my mind, I do want to compliment the swimmers of St. Pete for their magnificent dedication and attitudes. Although, those sunrises over Tampa Bay are the most beautiful of sights, it still takes a great deal of self-discipline to turn out for 6:00 am and work some 4,000 meters. I appreciate it so.

The Orlando Short Course Meters Meet held at the Pine Hills Boys' Club July 18th through the 20th had an attendance of 95. Both the pool (the water was 79 degrees) and the facilities were fine. Chris Carey, Steve Hall and Larry Parks all did fine work. The results for each event were posted within 5 minutes and the final results were received in the mail within 4 days. The meet was run well and the scanty 25 meter records were posted for all to shoot for—and shoot they did. At least 65 of those posted were bettered in the meet. Unfortunately, our St. Pete crew chose to ignore this meet. We had 7 swimmers who had a hand in 12 records. We mounted ~~four~~ relays. Those attending were Brownstein (the only woman), Uhrich, Walbolt, Patton, Maguire, Kohnken and myself—FHT. We had a real good supper and fine entertainment with marshall McMillan of Mobile, Alabama. Congratulations to CFM for a superior meet.

We should take note of two of St. Petersburg's finest young men—Bob Utley and David McDaniels. Bob and David swam in the National Competition in Texas a couple of weeks ago with outstanding results. Bob won the 200 meter I.M. and was second in the 400 while David was second in the 200 meter Free and third in the 400 and 1500 meter Frees. Congratulations to our high school students—their future looks outstanding!

Back in the latter part of July we marshalled our best contingent that we have had in some time to help with the age group meet. All the names are not available so I'll just say thank you to all who helped at that meet. We should be able to do more and besides helping, one can see some super swimmers of the future on their way up.

The Long Course Development meet held at North Shore on July 27th had an unusually good attendance of about 45.

Some time back in the short course season there was a postal competition out of the Raleigh, N.C. area. Ray Burns entered the 1650, the 400 I.M. and the 200 Fly and placed first. Your editor, FHT, also entered and placed first as well. Kay Schimpf likewise entered this section with a first place for St. Pete. Kay was the only one of us who entered the 50 Fly, the 50 Back, the 50 Breast and the 50 Free in which she placed second. It seems as though the postal events aren't very popular as there aren't many entries.

Southern Regional Long Course Championships

It was a weekend of almost no sunshine, a few light showers and no real weather delays—most unusual for this time of year. There were a total of 169 entries but there were several of those who didn't make it. Even so, it was the largest total we've had. Most everyone seemed to have a good time enjoying a fine spell of comraderie. As for the swimming, as usual there were some very happy people and some not so very happy people. The most notable swims were by Judy Humbarger who eclipsed the listed records in the 100 and 200 meter Backstroke events by well over a second in each—World Records, that is. Mary Barker also made a terrific showing recording personal bests for several events. Unseen and unsung persons who did their best to keep up with results and computer input and print out were: Enid Uhrich, Chris Carey, Pam Geiger and GLORIA MASTELL. Delays were caused by confusion over which lanes were which caused some swimmers to swim in lanes not assigned to them. Sue Kupfer, Ellen Walbolt, Betty Ferris and other team members did well keeping up on the action at the information and awards table. Did you realize that St. Masters

is one of the very few clubs to put dates on the medals? The supper gathering at Bev and Bill Tucker's Penn Flora Hotel was a convivial affair with a touch of the unusual thanks to Marshall McMillan's comedy/juggling act. About half of the 90 people at supper missed this prime performance. You'll catch it again...one day.

Emory University Invitational Masters Meet

Emory now has a 50 meter pool. The water was 80 degrees and crystal clear-a pleasure to swim in. A non-slip pad for electronically timing 91 entrants made it possible to use two outside lanes for warm up and down. Next time we need a good group to go. Mecklinburg AC Masters walked away with the visiting high point trophy. Oak Ridge was second and St. Pete was third by 8 points. We had Harold Ferris, Ernie Briscoe and FHT. Oak Ridge had 5. A couple of the MAC men set records better than National times. Winnie Prall did a fine job as meet director even though it did interfere with her swimming. The supper along side the railroad track was good and being startled by a real steam engine was an unexpected thing of note. While it was hot and humid with frequent, violent showers, the indoor pool was comfortable and serene. Really this is one to plan for next fall.

Southern Masters Long Course Invitational

This meet held at the LSU Natatorium in Baton Rouge, Louisiana on August 9th and 10th was supposed to be our Zone Championship. The "Crawfish" home club ran a first rate meet. There between 95-100 entries. The pool was superb but there were very limited toilet facilities and no locker or shower rooms (for a shower you could use a garden hose on the back entry). The Natatorium was built in a hurry for the National Sports Festival VI and ran out of funds. Facility shortcomings were well over come by the operation of the meet and the hospitality of the home club. Many fast and personal best times were recorded. The "old-fashioned" social and entertainment provided gratis was also tops. You ought to think about the next meet they have there.

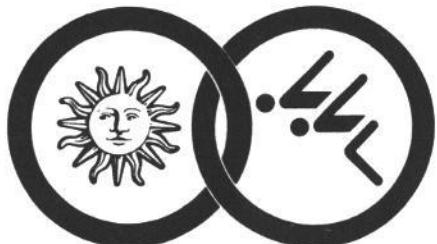
