For those of you swam at Delray last Fall , results, promised and paid have never been received so we only know what we learned there at the time.

The annual meet at the University of South Florida this past weekend was attended by most of the 152 who entered. Competition was strong with many races won by a touch. On Saturday perhaps the most outstanding swims were by Dick DiLala, UNA, who turned a sharp 48.50 for the 100 and 23.77 for the 50 Fly. I didn't attend Sunday and have received little on that days events. Let it be said that the meet was well run by Milt Bedingfield and his assistants and Officials Al Soltis , Bob Hertz, Jill and Paul Weller with John Ware at the computer controls. The hospitality, to which we have been accustomed of fruit, soft drinks and snacks gratis were in good supply and good.

Bottom Line from the LMSC Registrar: Do not assume that a swimmer's or club registrar's procrastination will become my last minute emergency.

The confusion and delays in re-registration has been regrettable and in most cases avoidable by simply following the way things were announced. Frequently changes are brought about without the approval of USMS. The increasing popularity of the legal profession for initiating suits on persons behalf has caused tightening of the way the companies require to continue insuring our activities. We have nothing to do but comply. The new wording of the waiver was a minor change but it was a firm requirement. By using the old wording the insurance would not have been in force. Some time ago Catie had asked that registrations and re-registrations be sent in as received. Not held to be sent in in large numbers. We need to remember that Catie is employed full time and registration is essentially a volunteer activity. Lets all try to do things right in the future. O K ?

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ELIGIBILITY:

The meet is open to all registered athletes 19 years of age as of 2/16/92. A copy of your USMS Registration Card MUST accompany each entry. International swimmers need a letter of introduction to the meet director. Competitors 19 to 24 years of age are advised that by competing in any Master swimming competition he/she may jeopardize his/her amateur status as outlined by FINA (in GBI) and collegiate governing bodies.

POOL FACILITIES:

The meet will be held at The Long Center (1501 N. Belcher, Clearwater) a brand new indoor Olympic facility, probably the best indoor swimming complex in Florida. Our competition will be held on eight lanes, nine feet wide with minimum 7-1/2 foot depth, with water temp 82. There will be a lane for continuous warm up and warm down (NO DIVING). We will have automatic electronic timing (buzzer start with touch pads, push button back ups). Of course we have full service dressing rooms, and food, soft drinks, juices and assorted junk food will be available.

ENTRY FEES:

Swimmers must pre-enter by mail. Send the completed and signed entry, seeding form and a copy of your current registration card. Entry fees are \$2.50 for each individual event and \$3.00 for relay teams. Competitors may enter and swim in no more than 5 individual events per day. All relay members must be a registered member of the team they represent.

ENTRIES DUE:

Entries must be in the hands of the meet director no later than February 8, 1992. NO DECK ENTRIES; EXCEPT RELAYS!!!!!! All money must accompany an entry form. If a swimmer is unable to attend the meet, call Penny Purvis at 813-462-6028. A full refund will be given as long as you contact us before 1:00 P.M. on Thursday, February 13, 1992. **Save yourself a hassle, check with your team registrar so a card can be obtained in plenty of time!**

SEEDING:

You are required to enter times for all events entered, NT or no time is not acceptable. Submit best competitive times, or a reasonable estimate, in meets more than two years ago, in a 25 yard pool. Heats will be seeded by times, not by age groups. Events are time finals. All heats will be slowest to fastest. The 1,000,500 and 400 I.M. will be deck seeded, combining men and women. Individual swimmers must check in person. Swimmers not reporting to the block when the event is called will be scratched without penalty.

SCHEDULE:

Warm up Friday	-	4:00 P.M.	-	Meet begins 5:00 P.M.
Warm up Saturday	-	8:00 A.M.	-	Meet begins 9:00 A.M.
Warm up Sunday	-	8:00 A.M.	-	Meet begins 9:00 A.M.

AWARDS:

Ribbons will be awarded first through eighth places. Special awards will be given for the following:

1. First, second and third place individual high point for men and women in their age group.
2. Team Trophies will be awarded for combined men and women 1st, 2nd and 3rd.

A competitor must swim in a minimum of 5 individual events to qualify for high point. Relay points do not count for individual high point awards.

SCORING:

First-9, Second-7, Third-6, Fourth-5, Fifth-4, Sixth-3, Seventh-2, Eighth-1. Double points will be given for relays for team awards.

SOCIAL:

After the meet Saturday (1:00 P.M.), we will meet at Capogna's Dugout (1653 Gulf to Bay Blvd.) for a social. Capogna's has great pizza, lots of carbs, a very casual atmosphere and is still willing to put up with the masters swimmers. Capogna's is a mile from the pool and directions will be given Saturday.

NOTE:

Masters swimming is a strenuous athletic activity and each participant is advised to consult a physician before undertaking the program. Under advice of the USMS Medical Committee, it is recommended that competitors exit from the sides of the pool and not from the ends of their lanes. Swimmers should wait until the last person in the heat finishes before crossing lanes to exit. Swimmers should wait at least one yard from the end of the lane, on the right side of the lane.

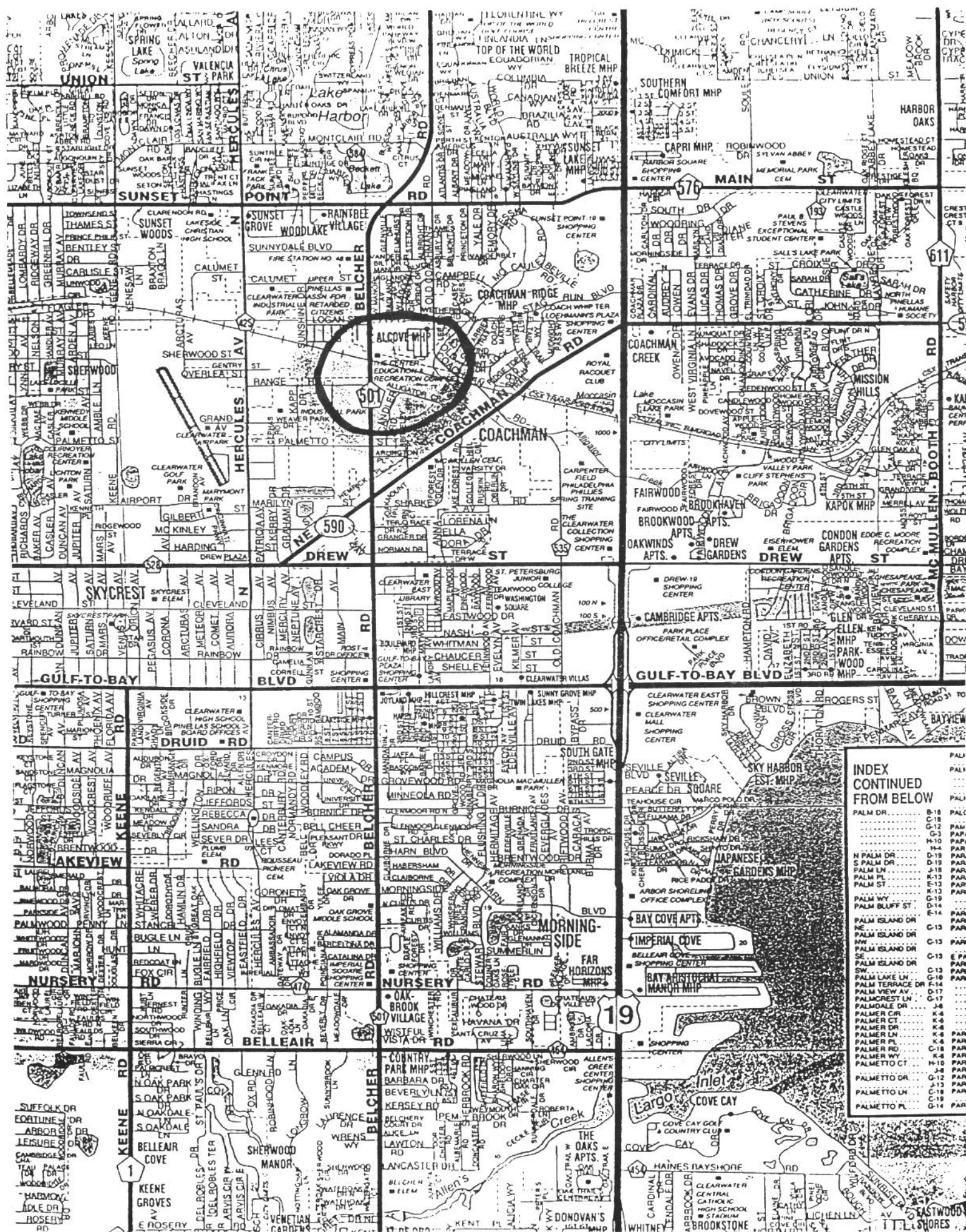

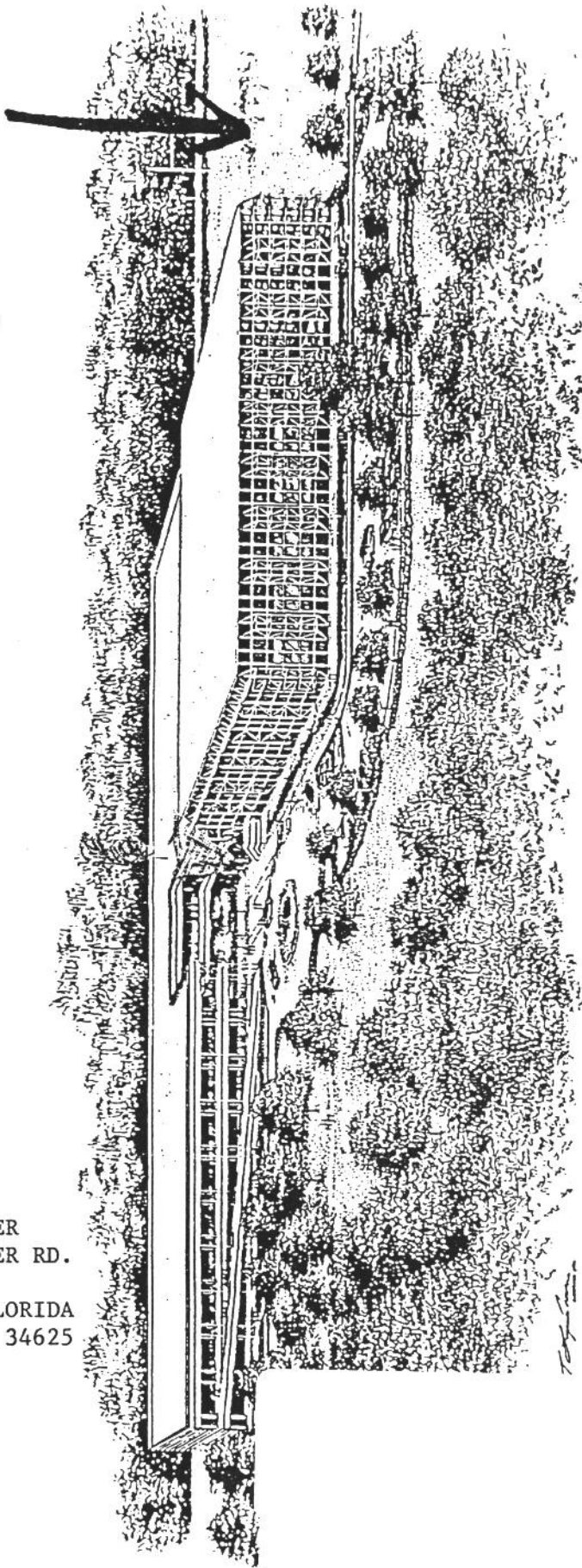

On January 11, 1992, the Buffalo State University Men's Swim Team challenged the Holmes Lumber Jax Masters Swim Team to a collegiate dual meet held at the University of North Florida Aquatic Center. A men's college format was used, NCAA officials and Colorado Automatic Timing. "Holmes Lumber Masters gave a very respectable performance against the college boys," said team captain Telfair Mahaffy. Holmes Lumber Jax' ol' folks won the 200 medley relay, 2nd in the free relay, 1st in 100 breast and 2nd in 50 free, 100 fly and 100 free.

This is the first dual meet ever between a masters team and a college team. Certainly Tiger Holmes (70), Joan Glaraton (64) and John Tinny (66) are the oldest folks EVER to swim in a collegiate dual meet.

After the 100 butterfly, a Buffalo State swimmer was heard saying to his teammate, "those old people are in shape."

The Buffalo team is coached by Keith Bouillon.

The Holmes Lumber Jax team is coached by Jack McKean.
