By-Laws Change - Staggered Elections for Chair & Treasurer and Vice Chair & Secretary

FL LMSC Chair Cheryl Kupan made a proposal at our annual meeting last November to update by-law 6.03 Elections as follows: The elections for Officers shall be elected at the Annual Meeting in staggered terms as follows: Odd years the Chair and Treasurer, Even years the Vice Chair and Secretary. The elections for Directors shall be held in even numbered years at the Annual meeting.

Club Transfers Important Details

- There is no longer a 60-day waiting period.
- Changing to unattached does not count against the allowable club changes.
- Changing workout group affiliation under the same parent club does not count against the allowable club changes.
- The club transfer count resets upon renewal for the next individual membership year.
- Full details can be found in the USMS rule book under article 201.3 Representation/Club Affiliation.

Member Self-Management Important Details

- **Starting Feb. 3**, members will self-manage their club and workout group affiliation through their My Account portal.
- Membership transfers will take effect immediately.
- Membership coordinators will no longer be able to submit transfer requests. The digital form within their My Account will be removed on Feb. 3.
 - If a membership coordinator is needed to help with a club transfer, this video tutorial will walk you through the new self-management transfer process and aid with general questions, or email the details to membership@usmastersswimming.org
- Information in ESTHER (USMS Admin Tools) will continue to be updated, allowing membership coordinators to see accurate registration history.

Transfer Information Resources

The guide to local operations has been updated with <u>transfer information</u>, and a <u>video tutorial and FAQs</u> in preparation for members managing their own club and/or workout group transfers. We recommend membership coordinators review these resources in case they receive questions from members.

Carter Elliott, representing Jacksonville, is the Florida LMSC Board Liaison to the Senior Games. The Senior Games is a series of local, statewide, and national swim

meets for ages 50+. These meets are an excellent way to participate in meets that are fun, low-pressure events.

I have been around swimming pools all my life, starting at the age of six, when, in 1963, I won my first blue ribbon (in Talladega, AL) by dog-paddling for 25 yards. I still have that ribbon. In my current day job, I am the Aquatics Director at the Good Shepherd Episcopal Church (Jacksonville) swimming pool. The 25 meter pool is 105 years old, and is a true outreach ministry of the church, providing a community fellowship atmosphere. I coordinate a wide range of aquatic activities, including lap swimming, swim lessons, lifeguard training, maritime training, aqua/physical therapy, scuba lessons, and age group swim teams. Besides swimming, I take Pilates classes at least three times per week, and play Mahjong as often as I can.

I have been a member of the Jacksonville Area Warriors Swim Team (the team name changed in 2025 from Holmes LumberJax) since 2017, when I relocated to Jacksonville from Atlanta, GA. I joined the LMSC Board in this role in 2023, and am honored to be representing Florida.

Holmes Lumber Jax (HLJ) Becomes Jacksonville Area Warrior Swimmers (JWS)

Whatever you do, do it well. Go hard. Go at it 100%. - Rogers "Tiger" Holmes

Holmes LumberJax (HLJ). What an odd name for a Masters swim team located in Jacksonville. But the above quote was the life philosophy of Tiger Holmes, a former University of Florida swim team captain, and the owner of the Holmes Lumber Company in Jacksonville. He organized HLJ in 1988, getting a group together to attend the 1988 World Masters Swim Championships in Brisbane, Australia. He gathered a group of 170 swimmers from across the state of Florida to fulfill his dream of competing on an international level. That team received local and national attention as several members of the group, including his daughter Mary, swept their age groups in their respective events. The team's women's relay teams swept every category and the men's individual and mixed relay teams won almost all events.

And so, the Holmes LumberJax Masters swim team was born and has remained a competitive club since 1988, with team members attending Florida, regional, and national meets as a team and as participating individuals.

Tiger Holmes died in 2018 at the age of 97. Many of the 1988 team members attended his memorial, some wearing the original team jackets from the Brisbane trip. The Masters team has maintained the HLJ name and legacy through the years, but as the team has evolved and new swimmers joined, very few of us who swam with, knew, or remembered Tiger, still swim on the team. In 2024, the decision was made to change the team's name to one more relevant to the current membership and to still reflect our foundation in Jacksonville. We are now the Jacksonville Area Warrior Swimmers, with the call letters JWS.

But we continue to remember Tiger's devotion to Jacksonville and the impact he has had on the Master's program in Florida. The team's pool at Episcopal High School pool has a plaque that recognizes, and reminds us of, this legacy.

We, JWS, are committed to providing quality training now and in the future for all adult swimmers in the Jacksonville area no matter their goals -- competitive or simply fitness. We continue to follow Tiger's legacy - *Whatever you do, do it well. Go hard. Go at it 100%*.
