D. WEBMASTER CHAIR REPORT (Meegan Wilson)

The 2020 Florida Senior Games, swim meet, will be held at Coral Springs December 4-12, 2020. The 2021 National Senior Games Swim Meet will (hopefully) be held at the International Hall of Fame in November 2021, if not, Coral Springs will be the back up.

Bob Jennings: Why did they move the Nationals from June to November?

Mike: Major concern for the summer heat in June in South Florida.

7. NEW BUSINESS

A. Officials: Mike Whaley

-- Develop protocol/pathway for training experienced Florida LMSC USMS Starters to receive a Florida LMSC Officials Chair endorsement/recommend to the USMS Officials Committee to credential the Starter as a USMS Referee. As recommended by USMS and Florida LMSC Job Descriptions, a protocol is needed to coordinating training and certification programs for new officials, especially for credentialed Starters to Referees, according to USMS guidelines.

Scott Bay & John Fox both agreed that this is a USMS issue to develop.

John: We are targeting USA Officials whose kids are now adults, to become USMS officials. As USA officials, they don't need to get USMS certified.

-- Determine funding and delivery means to provide current USMS Rule Books to credentialed Florida LMSC officials as mandated in the LMSC Job Descriptions

Scott Bay: USMS should provide these or check with the Officials Chair.

-- Discuss the merits of establishing a Mobile Training Team (MTT) to semi-annually conduct USMS Officials Training with the purpose of recruitment, training and refreshment of USMS Rules for Florida LMSC USMS Officials.

John Fox: This is very difficult to get these clinics organized/funded.

B. Update Florida LMSC Job Descriptions and By-Laws (Mike Whaley)

Last time the job description was updated was 2012 and the by-laws were last updated in 2017.

Meegan offered to update all the above.

On Thursday, January 23, I visited the Florida Sports Foundation in Tallahassee to discuss Florida plans to conduct the 2020 Florida Senior Games Swim Meet. I met with Karissa Pendleton, Event Manager and Swim Meet Coordinator, office: 850.577.7211, kpendleton@playinflorida.com

The 2020 Florida Senior Games, swim meet, will be held at Coral Springs, December, 2020. The 2021 National Senior Games Swim Meet will (hopefully) be held at the International Hall of Fame. The Coral Springs Aquatic Center will be a backup if the HOF is not available.

For 10 days in December, Florida Senior Games athletes will compete in the best the Greater Fort Lauderdale has to offer. The 2020 Florida Senior Games is the second of three years of Olympic-style Sports Festivals through 2021. The 2020 Florida Senior Games will be held in the Greater Fort Lauderdale area as well as the 2021 National Senior Games.

The Annual Florida Senior Games, attracts between 2,000 and 2,500 athletes and events are being held in 10 different Broward County municipalities. Approximately 2,500 senior athletes are expected to compete in the 2020 Florida Senior Games and an estimated 14,000 athletes at the National Senior Games. At the 2019 National Senior Games, athletes from 47 of the 50 United States and seven other countries, including Barbados, Canada, Cayman Islands, Netherlands, Slovakia, United Kingdom, US Minor Islands competed. Out-of-state athletes are eligible to compete without a qualifying performance at a Florida Senior Games Series Qualifier for an additional fee.

The Games in the Greater Fort Lauderdale in 2020 and will be a qualifier for the 2021 National Senior Games.

Senior athletes, age 50 and over, can find registration and competition information for the 24 sports of the Annual Florida Senior Games at www.floridaseniorgames.com. Individual event information can be accessed on each of the respective sports' pages on the site and can be requested by sending an email to games@flasports.com.

A qualifying performance at the Florida Senior Games Local Series qualifier is necessary for State of Florida athletes wishing to compete in Basketball Shooting, Bowling, Cycling, Golf, Pickleball, Shuffleboard, Swimming, Table Tennis, Tennis, and Track & Field.

Swimming: Coral Springs Aquatic Center is a world-class facility earning a top-quality reputation as a national and international training site, with a state-of-the-art Myrtha competition pool. Its 50-meter competition pool and 25-meter FINA designed pool brings more than 600,000 visitors to the Aquatic Center annually. The 2019 FSG Swim Meet was successfully held at the Coral Springs Aquatic Center.

LMSC New Business:

- Develop protocol/pathway for training experienced Florida LMSC USMS Starters to receive a Florida LMSC Officials Chair endorsement/recommend to the USMS Officials Committee to credential the Starter as a USMS Referee. As recommended by USMS and Florida LMSC Job Descriptions, a protocol is needed to coordinating training and certification programs for new officials, especially for credentialed Starters to Referees, according to USMS guidelines.

- Discuss the merits of establishing a Mobile Training Team (MTT) to semi annually conduct USMS Officials Training with the purpose of recruitment, training and refreshment of USMS Rules for Florida LMSC USMS Officials
- Review and update Florida LMSC Job Descriptions, September, 2012 and Florida By Laws, January, 2017.
